Ila Bromberg explained County taking over some town roads, Long Lake Rd. to Federal Forest #236, Church Corner Road, and Ondossagon Road. Long Lake Rd. has #1 priority.

Discussed bad corner at Long Lake Rd. and Church Corner Rd. Town board will look into it.

Discussed \$131,000. Federal money on hand they received in lieu of taxes on Federal land. County Board hasn't decided what to do with it.

Explained resolution prohibiting herbicide spraying on town right of ways and easements given to Power Co. and Phone Co.

Discussed snowplowing private driveways and possible not charging retired people.

George Berteau commented on bill #8505-8, aid to Elderly and Handicapped for transportation.
