ANNUAL MEETING

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:10 P.M. BY CHAIRMAN SCHWENZFEIER. MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING OF APRIL 7, 1979 WERE READ. THERE BEING NO CORRECTIONS OR ADDITIONS THEY WERE ACCEPTED AS READ.

CHAIRMAN SCHWENZFEIER DISCUSSED ROAD SIGNS MENTIONED IN THE MINUTES. DISCUSSED "40" TRADE WITH NEKOOSA EDWARDS.

ANDERS HOKANSON MENTIONED SIGNS AT CHURCH CORNER RD. AND LONG LAKE RD. INTERSECTION. RUSTIC ROADS BEING TAKEN OVER BY COUNTY IS PROBABLY NO LONGER FEASIBLE. IF WE WANT A RUSTIC RD. TOWN WOULD PROBABLY HAVE TO DO IT ON THEIR OWN.
